2. OTHER REASONS TO ACCESS A TIER 3 ALERT ISLAND.

People from abroad, whatever the reason for the trip with the following requirements:

- a) Transit passenger in a port or airport of the island in level 3, with final destination to another country or another place in national territory.
- b) Passenger arriving from outside the region or county of the Canary Islands who proves to have booked in a tourist accommodation establishment registered in the General Tourist Registry of the Autonomous Community.

3. TRAVELING BETWEEN ISLANDS

- a) You will not be able to travel to/from an island in tier 3 alert from any other Canary Islands, for reasons other than those indicated in section 1, not even in the case of an accommodation in a registered tourist accommodation establishment registered in the Canary Islands General Tourism Registry.

- b) Travelers over 6 years old who arrive at any of the Canary Islands from the island at level 3 are recommended, for any of the reasons indicated in section 1, to carry out a test 72 hours before travelling.

Accepted tests:

- PCR (rt-pcr COVID-19)
 - TMA
 - Antigen test for SARS-COV2 with a specified certainty of a 97% and a sensitivity over an 80% in accordance with the standardization of a country within the EU or the Economic European Region.
- c) The test can be completed within the following 72 hours of arrival, having to self-isolate in your residence until obtaining results and sending the negative result to the authorities or until the discharged date, if positive result.
 - d) Travelers between islands will be able to access a free test in the island of origin or destiny, in tier 3 alert or in any other island calling 900112061.

4. ACCESS OR DEPARTURE FROM AN ISLAND IN TIER 3 ALERT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FOR ANY OTHER REASONS MENTIONED IN POINT 1 & 2

5. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE MEASURES WILL BE SUBJECT TO WHAT IS ESTABLISHED IN THE LAW: DECRETO LEY 14/2020, 4TH SEPTEMBER, CONTAINING PUNISHMENT MEASURES REGARDING PREVENTION & CONTAINMENT AGAINST COVID-19, IN THE AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITY OF THE CANARY ISLANDS. WITHOUT IMPAIRMENT OF CRIMINAL LIABILITIES THAT MAY OCCUR DUE TO DOCUMENTARY FALSIFICATIONS
